

Supervision of Higher Degree by Research (HDR) Students Policy

1. PURPOSE

To ensure that supervisors provide a role model to Higher Degree by Research (HDR) students that is positive and conducive to a research culture of excellence, integrity, professionalism and mutual respect.

2. POLICY STATEMENT

- 2.1. Each HDR student will have an appropriately qualified and trained supervisory team comprised of a supervisor and one or more co-supervisors or associate supervisors.
- 2.2. The number of HDR students a supervisor has will be commensurate with the provision of effective intellectual interaction.
- 2.3. The Graduate Research School will maintain a register of appropriately qualified and trained supervisors (the Register of Supervisors of Higher Degree by Research Students).
- 2.4. It is mandatory that Curtin staff have current registration on the **Register of Supervisors** in order to be appointed as chairpersons, supervisors, co-supervisors or associate supervisors of HDR students. For External Associates, Emeritus and Adjunct staff, registration on the **Register of Supervisors** is voluntary.

3. RESPONSIBILITY FOR IMPLEMENTATION, COMPLIANCE MONITORING, MEASURING AND CONTINUAL IMPROVEMENT

These management positions are responsible for implementation and compliance monitoring of the policy in their work areas:

- 3.1. Deputy Vice-Chancellor, Research
- 3.2. Associate Deputy Vice-Chancellor, Research Training

4. SCOPE OF POLICY

This policy applies to all academic staff and HDR students.

Register of Supervisors of Higher Degree by Research Students

The database that lists academic staff members eligible to act in a supervisory role on a higher degree by research student's thesis committee.

Thesis Committee

The thesis committee or interim thesis committee of any higher degree by research student includes the positions of chairperson, supervisor, co-supervisor and associate supervisor.
